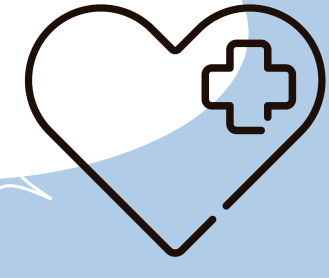
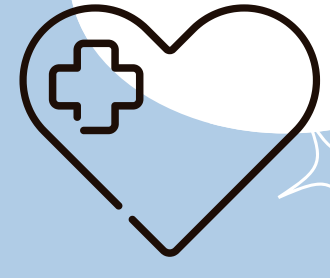

#### WORKFORCE CONNECTION YOUNG ADULT PROGRAM

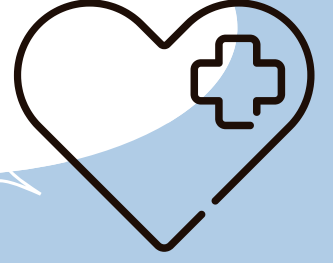
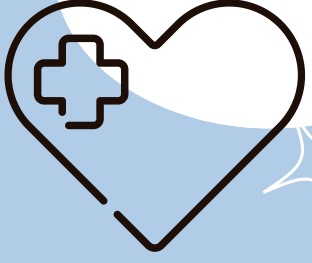
